Classes Ring 2 -

All classes will run under A2 - Art 238 2.1 All classes will run in draw order Late entries will ride at end of class. Riders who miss their drawn time will forfeit class Ribbons presented 1st - 5th

Classes Ring 3 -

All classes will run under A1 - Art 238 1.1 (clear rounds will share 1st equal) all rounds not timed. Except the Pole class which is non timed, rider must stay on course to be considered clear and trot/walk over each series of poles.

All classes will run in draw order
Late entries will ride at end of class.
Riders who miss their drawn time will forfeit class
Ribbons presented at gate to clear rounds
A friend/helper/parent or trainer may be in the ring with rider.

Yards & Parking:

Preferential parking will be given to riders who book covered, day or overnight yarding. If you have a yard your horse must be in this yard throughout the day and not tied to truck/float (to maximise parking)

Day yards are for use whilst show is running - not for overnight.

Entries close Wednesday prior to event. Draws will be sent out Friday prior to show.

*Masters Rider

(rider over 40yrs, not competing over 1m - August 2020 - August 2021- rug for winner 1st = 6 2nd = 4 3rd = 3 4th = 2 5th = 1 Points accumulated throughout series - rider must compete in at least 2 dates.
