EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

- Safe and proper use of equipment
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required
- Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible
- Ensuring all accidents and incidents are reported
- Help new workers, trainees and visitors to understand the right safety procedures and why they exist
- Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls

ENTRIES

Entries will only be accepted with full, clear payment & must be made on line at www.evoevents.co.nz

PAYMENT – IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!!

No rider will be able to compete at the show without entries being paid for prior to riding. Payment can be made via Poli (internet banking) or Stripe (credit card).

If you have any technical issues and payment isn't made you will need to pay directly to our bank account 12-3019-0013702-00 with the show you are entering as reference and the surname of person entered. Failure to do so will result in entries not being processed.

SCRATCHING/ REFUNDS

Entries withdrawn before close of entry are entitled to a FULL refund of all fees (except their online & admin fee).

After the Wednesday prior to the event, riders must present a doctor or vet certificate to receive a refund of 75% of entry fee, yard and accommodation fees, less \$12.50 admin fee and online fees. Vet/medical certificates are required within 72 hours of the event via email to info@woodhillsands.co.nz

The on-line entry fee & Administration fee is non refundable irrespective on when scratching.

Refunds will be paid out within 2 weeks of event to the bank account number on your Evo Events account - less any balance that might be owing the show if applicable. Please make sure your bank account information is up to date.

No tying horses to fences! No leading from horse back (ponying)

No horses on sand track behind office or in front of kiosk. **Only walk on the horse entrance sand track.**

Yellow tagged helmets must be worn at all times whilst mounted.

Curfew of 10pm no access to arenas or office area after this time - please no loud music after this time.

DRESS CODE: Casual tidy dress
All helmets must have Red/yellow ESNZ/NZPCA safety standard tag.
Back Protectors not required.

H/C rounds are allowed but must be paid for prior to jumping.

Entries should be made prior to the event but late entries will be accepted if room.

Late entries will ride first.



All riders who fall off onsite (in competition or not) must be checked by medics and fill out an incident report. Medic can be found at the medic station by the office.
