### CLASS PROGRAM

Classes will run in groups of 10 riders at a time. Each group will get to jump 2 rounds at their chosen height. Heights will be run 1st round at chosen height and second round in a range of up to 5cm higher for example 1.00 horse round 1 will run 1.00m round 2 100—105 All rounds will run in strict draw order—draw order will remain the same for both rounds. Classes will run under Art 238 2.1 A2 except for Mini Prix classes which will run: Art 261 5.3

*Riders can only select 1 class per day (that is 2 rounds of jumping per day)*

Course walks will be at set times—course will not change throughout the day

Riders are asked to compete then leave, treat the experience as you would going to the “supermarket” rather than a “bar”.

Classes may run throughout the day scores will be updated live on line (equestrian entries) and results will also be published on the Woodhill Sands facebook page -

No ribbons or rosettes riders who place 1st—6th will receive online certificates

The horse and Pony Mini Prix prize winners will receive a bag of Fiber Fresh Feed this can be collected at any event we are running within the next three months.

Prize money for the rider accumulators will be paid electronically at the conclusion of the event - riders please make sure you have your bank account details up to date on Equestrian entries and your date of birth recorded correctly so we have you in the correct rider series classes.

Riders may chose to ride on one or both days. Entries will close Wednesday 5th of September or earlier if capacity is reached before then.

**Classes will run over two rings at set times—riders will receive a draw with time for class and course walk Thursday prior to event. Classes might not run in numerical order ( do not expect class 1 horse 90 to be on at 9am or 1.00m horse to follow 90cm horse ) Timetable will be set on close of entries.**



Auckland is currently in Alert level 2 with restrictions.

Gatherings should not exceed 10 people. We urge riders and their support people **to maintain 2 metre distancing at all times—this will mean we do not have gatherings occurring on site**, this includes course walks, at toilets, in carpark and warm up.

Distance guides will be set up by office, toilet and kiosk to help. We are limiting the number of riders on the grounds at any one time with the revolving door program

**and ask everyone to wear masks when not riding.**

Limit your number of support people that come to watch—spectators must not gather in groups (unless from the same bubble) congregations of people will be asked to separate and maintain distancing.

We hope this level of social distancing is in place for a short time only—the more we do to help stop the spread of COVID-19 the quicker we can get back to our shows being run without restrictions.

We will be undertaking regular and a more elevated level of cleaning of the venue throughout the event.

Please use the QR scan at the gate and the equestrian entries text message tracing system.

If feeling unwell please stay at home.

Curfew of 10pm no one should be in area around jumping arenas or office after this time - please no loud stereos after this time.
