The Woodhill Sands Story

Woodhill Sands is a story of collaboration across the equestrian community, to ensure a lasting place for equestrian sports competition and training in the Auckland Region. Woodhill Sands Equestrian Centre is a community led development purchased by the sport through The Woodhill Sands Trust, in October 2017 to secure ongoing access to this wonderful venue.

The equestrian community undertook extensive fundraising, collecting funds for the required deposit, allowing the Trust to complete the purchase. This occurred in October 2017 with a 20-year mortgage from ASB Bank with support from Auckland Council as guarantor.

Woodhill Sands is now owned by the sport and all the riders that come from far and wide to train and compete at the facility

Woodhill Sands Trust and other groups from across the riding community hold events throughout the year catering for all levels across all the different areas of our sport.

Woodhill Sands is the only venue with a 100% natural, all-weather surface (sand based). This provides a wonderful solution for a riding surfaces to enable year round competition and training activity. Indeed, participation extends for a full 12 months across multiple disciplines most weekends. Elsewhere, winter competition on this scale is very limited due to unsuitable ground conditions. As a result, Woodhill Sands is a key venue for horse riders to train and compete all year round.

The Team at Woodhill Sands are excited about the future and look forward to sharing it with riders, supporters and spectators for many years to come.

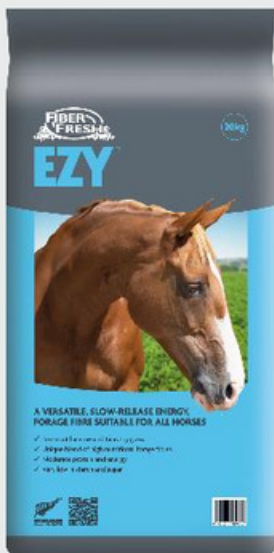

DRESS CODE: Casual tidy dress

. All helmets must have yellow ESNZ/NZPCA safety standard tag.

Ribbons for clear rounds. All classes will run in draw order. MAX 3 rounds per horse.

H/C rounds are allowed but must be paid for prior to jumping.

Entries should be made prior to the event but late entries will be accepted if room.

Late entries will ride first.



All riders who fall off onsite (in competition or not) must be checked by medics and fill out an incident report. Medic can be found at the medic station by the office.



Dogs are not allowed at Woodhill Sands events.

Special Series Sashes will be awarded to all riders who complete 6 clear show jumping rounds throughout the series. Best 2 rounds from each day will be counted.

SCRATCHING/REFUNDS:

Entries withdrawn before close of entry are entitled to a FULL refund of all fees (except their online & admin) fee.

After Wednesday prior to the event riders must present a doctor or vet certificate by the Thursday after the event to be receive a refund of 75% of entry, ground, yard and accommodation fees.

On Line entry fee & Administration fee is non refundable irrespective on when scratching. Refunds will be paid out within 3 weeks of event.
