## **The Woodhill Sands Story**

**Woodhill Sands is a story of collaboration across the equestrian community, to ensure a lasting place for equestrian sports competition and training in the Auckland Region. Woodhill Sands Equestrian Centre is a community led development purchased by the sport through The Woodhill Sands Trust, in October 2017 to secure ongoing access to this wonderful venue.**

**The equestrian community undertook extensive fundraising, collecting funds for the required deposit, allowing the Trust to complete the purchase. This occurred in October 2017 with a 20-year mortgage from ASB Bank with support from Auckland Council as guarantor.**

**Woodhill Sands is now owned by the sport and all the riders that come from far and wide to train and compete at the facility**

**Woodhill Sands Trust and other groups from across the riding community hold events throughout the year catering for all levels across all the different areas of our sport.**

**Woodhill Sands is the only venue with a 100% natural, all-weather surface (sand based). This provides a wonderful solution for a riding surfaces to enable year round competition and training activity. Indeed, participation extends for a full 12 months across multiple disciplines most weekends. Elsewhere, winter competition on this scale is very limited due to unsuitable ground conditions. As a result, Woodhill Sands is a key venue for horse riders to train and compete all year round.**

**The Team at Woodhill Sands are excited about the future and look forward to sharing it with riders, supporters and spectators for many years to come.**

### SCRATCHING/REFUNDS:

Entries withdrawn before close of entry are entitled to a FULL refund of all fees (except their online & admin) fee.

After Wednesday prior to the event riders must present a doctor or vet certificate by the Thursday after the event to be receive a refund of 75% of entry, ground, yard and accommodation fees.

On Line entry fee & Administration fee is non refundable irrespective on when scratching. Refunds will be paid out within 3 weeks of event.

H/C rounds are allowed but must be paid for prior to jumping. Entries should be made prior to the event but late entries will be accepted if room. Late entries will ride first.

All riders who fall off onsite (in competition or not) must be checked by medics and fill out an incident report. Medic can be found at the medic station by the office.

# **Show Jumping 2024**

## **Autumn Series Accumulator**

**21st April, 5th May, 26th May**

**Best SJ Horse** Classes : 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9,10

**Best SJ Pony** Classes : 11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19

**Mighty 90cm:** Rider cannot have been placed over 1.10m from April 2023 to April 2024

**Junior Rider:** Best placed 12yr old and under rider in classes 11,12,13 (rider age as of 30.03.24)

(Accumulator Rules: Points are gained for combinations (horses and riders) who must compete in a minimum of 2 of the winter series dates). Points awarded on placings, must have less than 12 faults to score points. If less than 3 in a class, points will only be awarded for rounds without faults. Only your 2 best rounds/scores per day will be counted.

Points will be gained for the leaderboard at each event with a placing 1st - 6th (Points 6,5,4,3,2,1)

**Winner to receive Rosette and Cover, 2nd - 4th will also receive Rosettes and prizes.**

**Series Winners will be presented at the Autumn Final Day.**
