The Woodhill Sands Story

Woodhill Sands is a story of collaboration across the equestrian community, to ensure a lasting place for equestrian sports competition and training in the Auckland Region. Woodhill Sands Equestrian Centre is a community led development purchased by the sport through The Woodhill Sands Trust, in October 2017 to secure ongoing access to this wonderful venue.

The equestrian community undertook extensive fundraising, collecting funds for the required deposit, allowing the Trust to complete the purchase. This occurred in October 2017 with a 20-year mortgage from ASB Bank with support from Auckland Council as guarantor.

Woodhill Sands is now owned by the sport and all the riders that come from far and wide to train and compete at the facility

Woodhill Sands Trust and other groups from across the riding community hold events throughout the year catering for all levels across all the different areas of our sport.

Woodhill Sands is the only venue with a 100% natural, all-weather surface (sand based). This provides a wonderful solution for a riding surfaces to enable year round competition and training activity. Indeed, participation extends for a full 12 months across multiple disciplines most weekends. Elsewhere, winter competition on this scale is very limited due to unsuitable ground conditions. As a result, Woodhill Sands is a key venue for horse riders to train and compete all year round.

The Team at Woodhill Sands are excited about the future and look forward to sharing it with riders, supporters and spectators for many years to come.

DRESS CODE: Plaiting & Jackets Optional. All riders must wear Back protectors, they are compulsory for any cross country jumping. A new minimum standard for Body Protectors (BETA EN13158 2009 or 2018 Level 3 or ASTM F1937) introduced 1 August 2020. All helmets must have Red/Yellow ESNZ/NZPCA safety standard tag.

DRESSAGE PHASE: Draw for Dressage will be available on Evo Events and emailed directly to riders by Friday 3pm prior to the event. Whips & Callers allowed for the Dressage Test. All Dressage tests are available from the Woodhill Sands Website.

CROSS COUNTRY/SJ PHASE: No jumping phase is timed. All Classes will run in blackboard order, Each class will be given a set time to jump. Yellow 50 course will be a blend of show jumps and natural fences - x bar jumps, logs etc. and will amount to approx. 10 fences in total. Other Mini ODE levels will have a SJ course of approx. 10 efforts and between 9—13 efforts cross country.

Black 95 plus will be the Woodhill Sands Pre Novice Dressage test, 105cm SJ and 95 XC.

SCRATCHING/REFUNDS:

Entries withdrawn before close of entry are entitled to a FULL refund of all fees (except their online & admin) fee. After Wednesday prior to the event riders must present a doctor or vet certificate by the Thursday after the event to be receive a refund of 75% of entry, ground, yard and accommodation fees.

On Line entry fee & Administration fee is non refundable irrespective on when scratching. Refunds will be paid out within 2 weeks of event.

All riders who fall off onsite (in competition or not) must be checked by medics and fill out an incident report. Medic can be found at the medic station by the office

Practice XC & SJ

**7TH & 9TH APRIL; 20TH MAY;
3RD & 5TH JUNE; 14TH & 16TH JULY .**

These fun training days are a great chance to get your horse jumping cross country and show jumps, There is usually one fully set Show Jumping course that you can adjust heights according to your experience level and practice rounds or a few jumps, plus a variety of cross country fences, which may include banks, ditches, corners, mobiles, skinnies and water etc. Room may be limited depending on weather, however with almost 3 acres of sand arenas we are guaranteed to run.

Riders are required to wear back protectors and provide emergency contacts if riding alone.

We strongly recommend having a friend, instructor or family member with

you when you jump, however we will have a staff member on hand at all times when you are jumping.

Fences open for jumping will be flagged. Just like in a normal competition situation we ask that you keep the red flag on your right hand side when jumping any fences, this will keep the track around the jumps flowing and avoid head on collisions.

We ask that all riders show courtesy to others riding in the same practice session (we try to limit the sessions to four riders per half hour) to give everyone space.

Time slots open from 9am.

9am - 12pm Jumps set 60 - 80cm

12pm - 1.30pm Jumps set 80 - 1.00m

1.30pm - 2.30pm - Open heights at riders discretion.

Course closes at 3.30pm so course can be set the next day for the Mini ODE.

**** JUST WANT TO DO THE 50cm course or ride in a dressage arena? We have slots for this too at the reduced cost of \$30 (if booking these slots you cannot jump the 65 - 95cm cross country or SJ courses).**

Bookings are required - spaces are limited.
