





The Woodhill Sands Story

Woodhill Sands is a story of collaboration across the equestrian community, to ensure a lasting place for equestrian sports competition and training in the Auckland Region.

Woodhill Sands Equestrian Centre is a community led development purchased by the sport through The Woodhill Sands Trust, in October 2017 to secure ongoing access to this wonderful venue.

The equestrian community undertook extensive fundraising, collecting funds for the required deposit, allowing the Trust to complete the purchase. This occurred in October 2017 with a 20-year mortgage from ASB Bank with support from Auckland Council as guarantor.

Woodhill Sands is now owned by the sport and all the riders that come from far and wide to train and compete at the facility

Woodhill Sands Trust and other groups from across the riding community hold events throughout the year catering for all levels across all the different areas of our sport.

Woodhill Sands is the only venue with a 100% natural, all-weather surface (sand based). This provides a wonderful solution for a riding surfaces to enable year round competition and training activity. Indeed, participation extends for a full 12 months across multiple disciplines most weekends. Elsewhere, winter competition on this scale is very limited due to unsuitable ground conditions. As a result, Woodhill Sands is a key venue for horse riders to train and compete all year round.

The Team at Woodhill Sands are excited about the future and look forward to sharing it with riders, supporters and spectators for many years to come.

Mighty 90cm (rider cannot have placed over 1.10m August 2022 - August 2023) **Junior Rider**: Best placed 12 year old and under rider in classes 10,11,12

(rider age as of 1.08.2023)

(Accumulator Rules: Points are gained for combinations (horses and riders) who must compete in a minimum of 2 of the winter series dates). Points awarded on placings. If less than 4 in a class, points will only be awarded for rounds without faults. Only your 2 best rounds/scores per day will be counted. Points for the Mighty 90cm and Junior rider leaderboards will not count towards Best Masters/Junior Rider.

Winner to receive Rosette and Cover, 2nd - 4th will also receive Rosettes and prizes.

Winter Winners will be presented at the Winter Series Final Day

Shelley Bridgeman Best Masters & Best Junior All Rounder Winter Series

- Masters Rider must be over 40 yrs old as of 1.04.2023
- Junior Rider must be under the age of 13 as of 13.08.2023
- Must have competed in two or more Woodhill Sands Winter series.
- Points will be awarded 1 -10 in each leader board the rider is placed on, Points are based on a combination of horse and rider, a rider may have more than one place on the leader board with different horses. The Grass Roots Dressage & Grass Roots Jumping series are not included in this All Rounder Winter Series.
