

Pony GP Super Series 2023-24

- 1. **Name** The Series will be named the Pony GP Super Series
- 2. It will be run at Woodhill Sands, Show Jumping Auckland, Brookby SJ, Northland SJ, Show Jumping Waitemata Summer SJ Shows.
- 3. The final will be at the Woodhill Sands Auckland SJ Champs in February 2024.

4. Participation

- 4.1 Riders and Horses must be registered with ESNZ, Horses must have an annual SJ Start paid.
- 4.2 Maximum age for rider is the season they turn 17 (ESNZ SJ Pony Rider rule)

5. Points

- 5.1 Points are retained per combination (rider and pony). A rider may ride more than one horse.
- 5.2 Points that are awarded to a combination will be forfeited if the pony in that combination starts in the Pony Grand Prix at the same show. Any points forfeited will be allocated to the next placed combination with the latter's points allocated to the next placed combination and so on down to the otherwise highest ranked unplaced combination. Prize money will not be affected.
- 5.3 Points will not be awarded to any combinations who have 12 faults or more in the first round.
- 5.4 The first six places to count, points will be awarded as follows 1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 3 Points, 5th = 2 Points, 6th = 1 Point.
- 5.5 The Woodhill Sands January GP SJ Show (6th & 7th January 2024) and the Woodhill Sands Auckland SJ Champs (3rd & 4th February 2024) will have double points awarded as follows 1st = 12 points, 2nd = 10 points, 3rd = 8 points, 4th = 6 Points, 5th = 4 Points, 6th = 2Point.
- 6. Competition
- 6.1. Competitions shall be run in draw order with a call back jump-off Art 238.2.2 4.

7. Obstacles

7.1 Max obstacles = 12 @ 1.10 - 1.20m, speed 350mpm.

8. Entry Fee & Prizes

- 8.1 Entry fee to be set relative to Prize money and will be determined by the group running the show. A levy of \$10 per start to be paid by the organising group to Woodhill Sands to fund the administration of the show and the prize money and prizes for the series.
- 8.2 Prize money will be paid out as advertised.

9. **Series Points**

9.1 Series Points from throughout the season will be added to a leader board. The organising committee for each show involved in the series is to forward the results of the class to Woodhill Sands within a week of the show. The winner of the series will be considered the person with the most points after the final round in February 2024. If entries are high on the final round and the class entries are closed or restricted, consideration will be given to riders who already have points on the leaderboard in relevance to their position (highest to lowest).
